

Scarborough Pubs

ALBERT, 58 NORTH MARINE ROAD, YO12 7PE, (01723) 361489

Opening hours: Summer: 12-12 (1am Fri & Sat). Winter: 3(12 Sat)-11(1.30am Fri & Sat)

The Albert is a single-roomed local located some 5 minutes walk from the town centre and close to the Scarborough Cricket Club. One house beer and a seasonal guest are offered together with a real cider. Bar meals are served 12am-7pm every day. A games area is situated at the rear of the main room. Live entertainment is a regular feature weekend evenings with quiz nights every Wednesday. Multi-screened TVs show major sporting events.

AMBASSADOR HOTEL, 36-38 THE ESPLANADE, YO11 2AY, (01723) 362841

Opening hours: 10-1am

This hotel is located at the end of an impressive Victorian Terrace overlooking the South Bay and above The Spa. A comfortable lounge bar is open to non-residents and offers a regularly rotating guest ale with bar meals available throughout the day. All accommodation is en-suite and there is a "Spa and Beauty" facility. The Ambassador can cater for business conferences for up to 120 delegates. Quiz nights and live entertainment take place when coach parties are booked in.

ANGEL, 46 NORTH STREET, YO11 1DF, (01723) 365504

Opening hours: 11-midnight; 12-midnight Sun

Friendly town-centre local close to the main shopping area, with a single-room horseshoe bar displaying an excellent collection of saucy seaside postcards. An interest in sport and games is reflected in the impressive array of trophies won by various pub teams and the large-screen TVs for viewing sporting events. Occasional guest beers are added in summer. It has a surprisingly spacious and well-appointed patio garden at the rear with two of its boundary walls displaying a superb example of "graffiti wall art" depicting Angels in a misty woodland setting.

BLACK LION HOTEL, 12 NORTH STREET, YO11 1DF, (01723) 363717

Opening hours: Winter: 12-7(11 Thu, midnight Fri & Sat, 6 Sun). Summer: 12-11(midnight Fri & Sat, 10 Sun)

This traditional two-roomed town centre local is situated close to the main shopping precinct. Two guest beers are offered with an additional one in summer (from Marston portfolio). Freshly cooked meals are served lunchtimes (except on Monday). Accommodation is available. Live entertainment features at weekends and at the rear is a partially covered drinking/smoking area.

BLACK SWAN HOTEL, 26 QUEEN STREET, YO11 1HA, (01723) 373074

Opening hours: 11-11; 12-11 Sun

Traditional single roomed street corner local with an "Olde world" feel. A rotating guest ale is offered with an additional ale during holidays and the summer season. Pub teams participate in local pool and domino leagues. To the rear is located an award winning beer garden/smoking area. Bar snacks are planned for summer.

BOATMAN'S TAVERN, NORTHSTEAD MANOR GARDENS, YO12 6PF, (01723) 368791

Opening hours: Summer: 11-5; weekends only, Easter to May & Sept; closed Winter

Probably the smallest Pub in Yorkshire located adjacent to the Open Air Theatre. Essentially a converted hut with a padded bench which seats 3 adults and tiny bar. A serving hatch is busy during warm weather and there are several tables fronting the water park where parents can keep an eye on their offspring. Opening hours can become flexible at the start and end of the season so it's best to check by phone.

CAROUSEL, FALCONERS ROAD, YO11 2EN, (01723) 343291

Opening hours: 11-11; 11-midnight Fri & Sat; 12-11 Sun

The Carousel Pub Restuarant is one of the "Brewers Fayre" chain and situated in a recently constructed building close to the shopping precinct. Two house cask ales are offered. Early breakfasts and all-day meals are served daily. There are also the popular "Theme nights" with "all you can eat" buffets which can be enjoyed in place of the regular dishes.

CASK INN, CAMBRIDGE TERRACE, YO11 2LQ, (01723) 500570

Opening hours: 12-midnight

The Cask Inn is a traditional pub located on the outskirts of the town centre and has several rooms on the ground floor serving home-cooked food throughout the day. Rotating guest ales are available in addition to the two regulars. There are two games areas. The "Cask Club" function room is situated below the main bar and is home to the Scarborough Blues Club every Thursday night. Jazz nights are held on Wednesdays. The Cask is popular with locals and students.

CELLARS, 35-37 VALLEY ROAD, YO11 2LY, (01723) 36715

Opening hours: 4-11 winter; 12-midnight Sat; 12-10.30 Sun

Scarborough's longest consecutive GBG entry (15 years), a family-run pub converted from the cellars of a Victorian house. Six handpumps dispense guest beers from micros around the country. Excellent locally sourced, home-cooked food is available lunchtimes and evenings, with Sunday lunches particularly popular. Quiz night is Tuesday, open mic night is Wednesday, local acoustic acts appear on Thursday, and Saturday is live music night. The patio fronting the pub is popular in summer.

COMMERCIAL HOTEL, 83 FALS GRAVE ROAD, YO12 5EG, (01723) 366338

Opening hours: 12-11.30; 12-midnight Fri-Sun

Recently refurbished, this busy traditional local is located in Falsgrave with an open-plan room divided into a lounge and function area plus a separate games room (pool and darts). Two regular beers are offered together with one guest. Saturday is "band night", also live music on Sunday afternoons with "open-mic" nights every Monday. There are also weekly quiz nights.

CROWN TAVERN, 8 SCALBY ROAD, YO12 5QB, (01723) 378204

Opening hours: 12-11; 12-11.30 Fri & Sat

This Grade II listed pub is one of the Marston plc chain and is a busy local situated 10 minutes walking time from the town centre. Real ales are available from the Marston portfolio with two regulars and two changing guests. There is an extensive all day food menu on offer together with various food theme nights. Sunday quiz nights are popular and the pub has a pool and darts team which compete in local leagues.

ESPLANADE HOTEL, BELMONT ROAD, YO11 2AA, (01723) 360 382

Opening Hours: Daily from 11am until midnight. Bar Menu – Served Daily 11.30 am – 5.00 pm.

Cliff-top location in South Bay. Great view of the South Bay from the hotel bar makes it worth the effort of a visit.

GOLDEN BALL, 31 SANDSIDE, YO11 1PG, (01723) 353899

Opening hours: 11-11; 12-10.30 Sun

Pub with striking mock Tudor appearance situated on the seafront, with fabulous views across the harbour to the lighthouse and South Bay. The only Sam Smith's pub in Scarborough, it is multi-roomed and features a sea-view bar, downstairs bar (doubling as a function room), family room and a popular beer garden at the rear. It becomes a cosy gem in winter, warmed by a real fire. This pub upholds the Sam Smith's policy of "Music Free" and is ideal for those who prefer a quiet drink.

HIGHLANDER BAR, 15-16 THE ESPLANADE, YO11 2AF, (01723) 365627

Opening hours: 11-11; 11-11.30 Fri & Sat; 11.30-11 Sun

This pub is an integral part of the Highlander Hotel and offers a Scottish-themed lounge, cellar bar and carvery. Enjoy superb views of the South Bay from the patio. An extensive collection of malt whiskies is on show (800 bottles), 20-25 are regularly on sale, alongside a changing guest beer in addition to the three house beers. An excellent lunch menu and Sunday carvery draw a large local trade. There are also food theme nights - Quiz nights on Thursday. No loud music or machines spoil the atmosphere. Smokers are catered for at the rear.

HOLE IN THE WALL, 26-32 VERNON ROAD, YO11 2PS, (01723) 325996

Opening hours: 4-11; 12-midnight Sat; 12-11 Sun

Built in the 1840's, the pub has a split-level interior with three seating areas. This friendly, conversational pub is handy for the town centre and spa complex. Rotating guest beers are offered from the Marston's portfolio. There is an outside covered and heated smoking area to the side of the pub. Live music can be enjoyed every weekend evening. The pub holds a "bar boot" event on Sunday afternoons.

INDIGO ALLEY, 4 NORTH MARINE ROAD, YO12 7PD, (01723) 350599

Opening hours: 4-11; 12-11 Fri-Sun

Recently upgraded into a welcoming open-plan pub retaining a rustic feel and sporting a logburner, this venue has come back on the real ale and traditional cider trail after a few years in the wilderness and has been voted as CAMRA runner up town pub of the year 2013. It is a true free house, with bare floorboards and the advantage of pool, darts, dominoes and chess. Locally brewed Indigo Ale (from Wold Top) and draught Thatchers cider complement specialist lagers. It is dog- and child friendly, with live entertainment every Friday and Saturday.

IVANHOE HOTEL, BURNISTON ROAD, YO12 6QX, (01723) 366063

Opening hours: 11-10.30; 11-11.30 Fri & Sat; 12-11.30 Sun

A large community pub on the outskirts of town adjacent to the North Cliff Golf Course. The large single room is divided into a spacious drinking/dining area with horseshoe shaped bar, conservatory and games area. Freshly cooked meals are served throughout the day. En-suite accommodation is available. Outdoors is a small pets compound for the children, a covered smoking area and spacious beer garden.

LEEDS ARMS, 26 ST MARY'S STREET, YO11 1QW, (01723) 361699

Opening hours: 11-11 (midnight Mon); 11-midnight Fri & Sat; 12-11 Sun

Small, thriving one-roomed, Grade II listed pub situated in the Old Town area of Scarborough behind the harbour. Fishing and yachting pictures and memorabilia adorn the walls. An eclectic mix of locals gives rise to lively conversation. There is always a magnificent display of hanging baskets outside. The pub is dog but not children friendly. There is a covered smoking area at the rear of the pub. Quiz nights are on Monday.

LEEDS HOTEL, WEST SANDGATE, YO11 1QL, (01723) 354117

Opening hours: 10-midnight; 12-midnight Sun

The Grade II listed Leeds Hotel is located close to the sea-front and provides a warm welcome to locals and visitors. This is a single roomed pub with horseshoe bar and adorned with numerous photographs relating to the local fishing industry. Four cask ales are offered (2 regulars & 2 guests), usually sourced from Wold Top. En-suite accommodation is available in 5 letting rooms, presently on a room only basis. Pub teams participate in local darts league.

LORD ROSEBERY, 85-87 WESTBOROUGH, YO11 1JW, (01723) 361191

Opening hours: 9am-midnight

The Lord Rosebery was originally built in 1895 as the Scarborough Liberal Headquarters and then acquired by the CO-OP after World War 2 who opened a walk-round store in the building. This busy pub is on two levels with a bar located on both. Frequently changing guest beers are available and food is served all day every day.

MERCHANTS, 27-29 EASTBOROUGH, YO11 1NG, (01723) 351426

Opening hours: 2-midnight; 12-midnight Sat; 12-11 Sun

The Merchant is a multi-levelled single-roomed pub with an upstairs function room and bar, located close to the South beach. Of note is the main bar which is constructed with sawn-off pieces of railway sleepers. Meals are served from the next door cafe on request. En-suite accommodation is available. This is a live-music orientated establishment with events occurring most nights of the week and is home to the Scarborough Folk Club who meet on Mondays

MIST BAR, 66 ST THOMAS STREET, YO11 1DU, (01723) 360030

Opening hours: 12-midnight; 12-3am Fri & Sat

Mist is a busy and lively town-centre, single-roomed, lounge bar with comfortable modern furnishings. In addition to a regular cask ale, draught continental lagers and a wide selection of bottled beers are offered. Home cooked meals are served throughout the day. Live entertainment features at weekends. To the rear is a partially covered drinking/smoking area.

NAGS HEAD, 35 HIGH STREET, SCALBY, YO13 0PT, (01723) 373229

Opening hours: 12-2.30, 5-midnight; 12-midnight Fri-Sun

This Grade II listed "ale house", the Nags Head is a traditional two-roomed local, situated at the heart of picturesque Scalby village - visitors and locals are welcome alike throughout the year. There is a sociable bar, comfortable lounge and cosy snug. Home-cooked food is available at lunchtimes. The Nags Head plays an integral part of village life with the organising of money raising events for local charities. Live music is featured on the last Saturday of the month and weekly quiz nights are every Tuesday.

NORTH RIDING BREW PUB, 161-163 NORTH MARINE ROAD, YO12 7HU, (01723) 370004

Opening hours: 12-midnight; 12-1am Fri & Sat

Scarborough's only brewpub and current Local CAMRA Town Pub of the Year, it is on the North Bay, just down from the cricket ground. It has now served nearly 2000 guest beers in addition to its own North Riding beers. Two or more guests come from microbreweries from far and wide and it is a regular outlet for Elland, Thornbridge and Yorkshire Dales. The pub has a public bar, a quiet lounge and an upstairs dining room serving home-cooked food, all with real fires. Quiz night is Thursday.

OLD SCALBY MILLS, SCALBY MILLS ROAD, YO12 6RW, (01723) 500449

Opening hours: 11(12 Winter)-11

This popular seafront local was originally a watermill but has seen many uses over the years - old photographs and prints chart its history. Admire the superb views of the North Bay from the sheltered patio, conservatory or lounge. The Cleveland Way reaches the seafront here and there is a Sealife Centre nearby. Children are welcome in the lounge. North Bay ale from the local Wold Top Brewery is only available here; guest beers invariably include a stout, porter or mild.

POACHERS BARN, OSGODBY LANE, OSGODBY, YO11 3QH, (01723) 449134

Opening hours: 12-midnight

Food: 12-9.30; 12-8 Sun

The Poachers Barn is a friendly community pub situated some 3 miles from the Scarborough town centre in Osgodby village. Two regular cask beers and a rotating guest, all from the Marston portfolio, are available. An all-day food menu is offered and there are food theme nights (meals may be eaten in the main bar or restaurant). Accommodation is available. Live entertainment is on Friday nights and quiz nights are popular. Smokers are catered for at the rear of the pub. Dogs are welcome, but not in the restaurant.

PRINCE OF WALES, 2 CASTLE ROAD, YO11 1XA, (01723) 373517

Opening hours: 11-11; 11-1am Fri & Sat; 12-11 Sun

This busy single-roomed town-centre local is located just a few minutes walk from the shopping precinct and is renowned for its friendly atmosphere. An L-shaped bar serves the main drinking area. Accommodation is available. Regular live entertainment takes place during weekend evenings.

RAMSHILL HOTEL, 66 RAMSHILL ROAD, YO11 2QG, (01723) 364856

Opening hours: 11-11.30

A busy single-roomed local located on the A165 Scarborough to Bridlington road in the South Cliff area of town. The large main room has an L-shaped bar and a separate games area. Pub teams participate in local leagues. Live entertainment features during weekend evenings. An outdoor smoking area is provided at the rear.

RED SQUARE, 1-3 THE CRESCENT, YO11 2PW, (01723) 365766

Opening hours: 12-1am

Food: 12-9

Red Square is a single roomed cocktail bar located on The Crescent close to the town centre and part of a Grade II listed Georgian building. A seasonal guest ale is offered together with a wide range of bottled craft ale, both British and International. Old Rosie draught cider is also available. An extensive food menu is available with the Sunday roast a favourite. This bar is family friendly during the day and dogs are also welcome. A smoking facility is provided in the terraced garden.

RIVELYN HOTEL, 1-4 CROWN CRESCENT, YO11 2BJ, (01723) 363513

Opening hours: 5-11

The Rivelyn Hotel, located on the South Cliff, a few minutes walk from the town centre, has recently been acquired by the owners of the Scarborough Brewery and award winning Valley Bar. The bar area is comfortably furnished and offers two cask ales from the Scarborough Brewery together with a selection of Belgian and German bottled beers. Entertainment and activities are being planned for the future.

SCALBY MANOR HOTEL, BURNISTON ROAD, YO13 0DA, (01723) 503452

Opening hours: 10-11

Scalby Manor Hotel is located off the A165 just north of Scalby Beck and is part of the "Crown Carveries" chain. Meals are available throughout the day, with breakfasts served between 9am -11am (every day in Summer , Sat & Sun in Winter) and the carvery from 11am - 9.30pm every day of the week - no booking is required. The cask ale is cask marque approved. Popular with locals and visitors from the nearby caravan park. At the side is a spacious beer garden encompassing a childrens play area. Smokers are catered for at the front. Occasional live entertainment features at weekends.

SCARBOROUGH ARMS, 1 NORTH TERRACE, YO11 1HU, (01723) 362883

Opening hours: Winter:5-11;12-11 Sat&Sun Summer:12-3,5-11;12-11 Sat&Sun

Food: 12-2.30, 5-8.30; 12-8 Sun

An extensively renovated two-roomed, family friendly, pub based on a medieval theme and renowned for its quality cuisine. One house beer plus a couple of seasonal guests are offered (more in Summer). Home cooked meals are served every evening (plus lunchtimes in Summer) together with Sunday lunches. Karaoke is featured at weekends. Smoking area at front of building. Car parking either on-street (time limited between 9am-7pm) or adjacent P&D area.

SCARBOROUGH FLYER, 4-13 ST NICHOLAS STREET, YO11 2HF, (01723) 366433

Opening hours: 10-11.30 Mon-Wed; 10-1.30am Thu-Sat; 10-midnight Sun

The Barbican has recently been refurbished, transforming the venue into the modern trendy bar it is now and is located in the "night-life" heart of the town centre. The large split-level main bar is divided into several eating areas (all disabled friendly). There are four rotating guest ales on offer. All day food menus are available. Popular with party-goers, when the music is turned up. Football fans can "catch the match" on the giant screen. Live entertainment features on occasional weekends.

SCHOLARS BAR, 6 SOMERSET TERRACE, YO11 2PA, (01723) 449836

Opening hours: 4.30-midnight; 12-midnight Fri-Sun

A warm, friendly atmosphere prevails at this town-centre pub at the rear of the main shopping centre voted as CAMRA runner up town pub of the year 2013. It has a large front bar and a games room. Seven handpumps serve a rotating range of beers from Ossett, Fernandes, Rat and other breweries throughout the Yorkshire region. Numerous screens show major sporting events. Twenty-eight pints are the prize at the Thursday quiz, and more free beer can be won rolling dice on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Sunday nights. During the Football Premier League "Off-season" the pub is closed Sunday afternoons (opening at 7pm).

SPA HOTEL, 45 VICTORIA ROAD, YO11 1SH, (01723) 350345

Opening hours: 12-3, 6.30-11; 12-11 Fri-Sun

LocAle

This recently refurbished popular locals pub, located a few minutes walk from the town centre, has a single main room with several drinking areas and game area. A regular cask ale plus three rotating guests are offered. Live entertainment is frequently featured at weekends. Pub teams participate in local darts, pool and domino leagues. Quiz nights are on Thursdays.

SUN INN, 21 ST THOMAS STREET, YO11 1DY, (01723) 341067

Opening hours: Winter: 4-midnight;12-2.30am Fri & Sat;12-1.30am Sun. Summer: 12-midnight(2.30am Fri & Sat,1.30am Sun)

This town-centre pub is located close to the "night life" area and can be lively at weekends. A main room is divided into drinking, eating and games areas. Meals are served lunchtimes and evenings during summer and throughout the day on Fridays and Saturdays in winter. Live entertainment features at weekends. Major sporting events can be viewed on large screens. Smokers are catered for at the rear of the pub. P & D parking is also available nearby.

TAP & SPILE, 94 FALSGRAVE ROAD, YO12 5AZ, (01723) 507666

Opening hours: Summer: 2(11 Fri & Sat,12 Sun)-midnight(11 Sun). Winter: 4(12 Sat & Sun)-midnight(11 Sun)

Sympathetically restored Grade II listed public house, not far from the town centre, serving five cask ales. There are two main rooms plus a small snug - local memorabilia is displayed. The T & S is a venue for live music (particularly blues and jazz). This thriving local has a friendly atmosphere; TV sports are shown in one bar. A beer garden is situated at the rear. Dogs are welcome in the tap room.

TENNYSON ARMS, 69-71 DEAN ROAD, YO12 7QS, (01723) 363912

Opening hours: 10-midnight; 10-1am Fri & Sat; 11-midnight Sun

A traditional two-roomed locals pub with tap room and lounge bar some 5 minutes walk from the town centre. Two regular cask ales plus an occasional guest are offered (during Summer and Bank Holidays). The pub is family friendly - darts and pool can be enjoyed in the tap room. Live entertainment features each weekend.

THE COURTYARD, 4/6 VERNON RD, YO11 2NH, (01723) 377596

Opening Hours; Mon – Sat: 12PM – LATE , Sunday: 12PM – 11PM

The Courtyard is a unique and multi faceted venue. Offering something for all tastes, be that a couple enjoying a romantic meal with fine wine, a group of work friends having a cocktail lesson or a family enjoying fresh cooked food in a beautiful patio surrounding.

VALLEY BAR, 51 VALLEY ROAD, YO11 2LX, (01723) 372593

Opening hours: 12-midnight (1am Thu-Sat)

A cellar bar with six handpumps offering mainly microbrewery beers, usually including one or more from Scarborough Brewery. Up to eight real ciders and perries are also available with over 100 bottles of Belgian beers including Cantillon. Further rooms offer additional seating upstairs, which can be used for meetings. There is also a pool table upstairs. CAMRA National Cider Pub of the Year 2007 and local CAMRA Town Pub of the Year 2005 and 2007. Accommodation is available at a discount to CAMRA members

VICTORIA HOTEL, 79 WESTBOROUGH, YO11 1TP, (01723) 355495

Opening hours: 11-11 (11.30 Mon); 11-11.30 Fri & Sat

The Victoria Hotel is located in the town centre directly across from the Railway Station and notable as the birthplace of actor Charles Laughton. A large main room has a contemporary bar area, eating area and pool playing area. Freshly cooked "all-day" meals are served together with a food eating challenge (the 8lb "Goliath Burger" - free if completed). En-suite accommodation is available. Live entertainment features at weekends. At the rear is a partially covered smoking area. Children are welcome till early evening.

WATERHOUSE, 2 ST THOMAS STREET, YO11 1DR, (01723) 350975

Opening hours: 12-2.30am

Food: closed Mon; 12-8; 12-3 Sun

This single-roomed bar is located at the heart of the town centre (formerly The Plough - a Camerons stronghold). A real ale is offered at weekends when live music features. A family friendly establishment but dogs only welcome outside of food hours.
